'Now that I am a little financially stabilized in my life. I try to do as much charity work as possible", said Simon Goh, CEO of Valiant Group.

'Last year, my company Valiant Network donated and installed free bio-metric Intelligent locks to St. Andrew's Autism Centre (SAAC)", he added. In addition, Valiant Network pledged \$100,000 to SAAC from the proceeds of the sales of 2,000 locks (\$50 will be donated for each lock sold).

Valiant Group's entrepreneur philanthropy takes a deeper meaning with the recent outright donation of S\$10,000 (Singapore Dollars Ten Thousand) to Kheng Chiu Happy Lodge (Kheng Chiu Loke Tin Kee Home). This Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative was carried out in conjunction with local evening Chinese newspapers, Shin Min Daily News which endorses this charity event. In addition, Valiant Network will donate and install Valiant bio-metric locks and CCTV cameras and cabling works for the protection of the sheltered Home's premises.

Kheng Chiu Happy Lodge, a 150-residents Sheltered Home was built in 1999 at a cost of \$8 million, with \$7 million funding from the then Ministry of Community Development and the remaining \$1 million from public donations. Situated at 70 Tampines Avenue 4, this 7-Storey charity building has 44 rooms for both male and female residents and is near the town centre with

amenities like Tampines MRT station & bus interchange, polyclinic, regional library, supermarket, shopping centres, etc.

At the cheque presentation ceremony on 19 June 2013, graced by Mr Mah Bow Tan, (Member of Parliament, Tampines GRC and former Minister for National Development) and Mr. Foo Jong Peng, Chairman of Kheng Chiu Happy Lodge, Simon Goh said that he is happy to do his bit for society and hopes that more companies will step forward to help the needy. Mr Mah echoed his sentiments and thanked Valiant Network Pte Ltd for the donation at this special event, held in conjunction with the Home's celebration of Father's Day and Dumpling Festival.

When interviewed for this story, Simon Goh said, "Today, I view life differently, and will go all out to help others to make a difference in their lives with all my means. In my life, I have had the good fortune of meeting people who helped me progress and prosper. I feel this is the right time to pay back".

As part of Valiant Group's commitment to do more for the less fortunate, Valiant Network will be extending this charitable initiative to other old folks homes, charities and needy families. Meanwhile, its parent company Valiant Security will also start bursaries and scholarships for their security employees' children and expand their opportunities for better education opportunities.
